

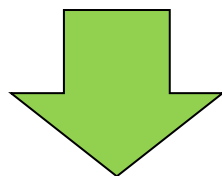

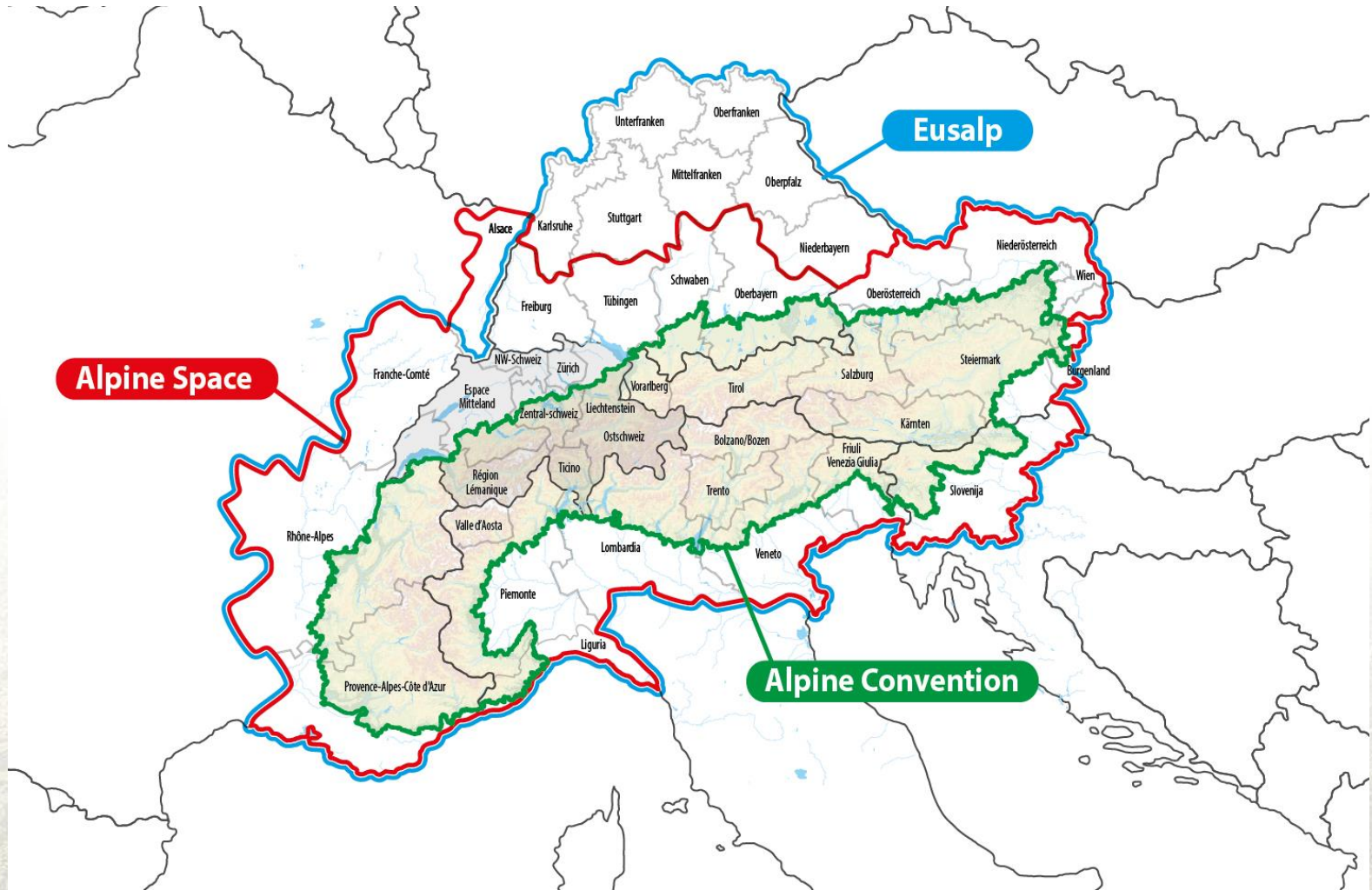
EUSALP: AN ALPINE MACROREGIONAL STRATEGY

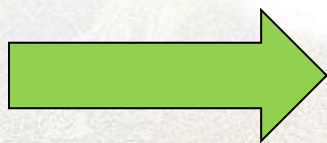

3. To make the Alpine Region's environmentally sustainable and attractive.

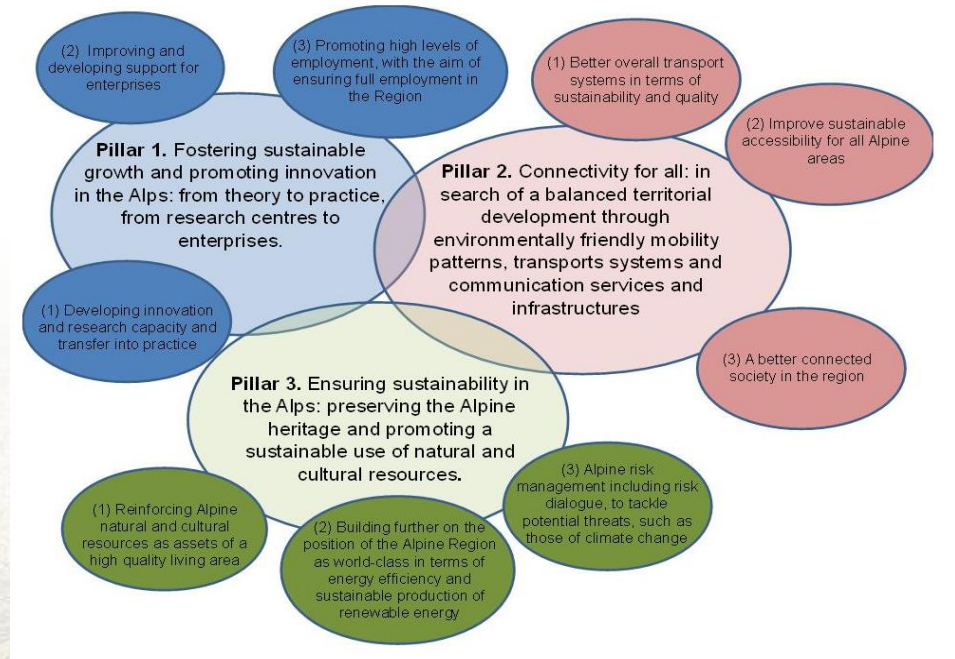


3 PILLARS, 9 ACTION GROUPS

EUSALP PILLARS AND AGs



Priorities

Increase the Digitalisation process of the Alpine Area:

- Strategies about technological infrastructures
- Opportunities of digitalisation (i.e. E-Government ...)

At the moment:

- process partly in place, mostly in the common framework of the European Digital Agenda
- some documents already available (i.e. Alpine Convention Digital Agenda)
- technological expertise requested



Priorities

Increase the Accessibility to services in the Alpine Area:

- Integrated strategies for services of general interest

At the moment:

- influenced by different regulatory and organizational frameworks
- service experts needed more than technological ones

Synergies with the INTESI project:

- project partners would like to collaborate with AG5 to define a common strategy;
- the project is defining a common SGI Strategy for the Alpine Area,
- the project already provides us with a survey of e-services already available in the alpine area



Aims of the AG5

- Propose technical solution with focus on ICT
- Propose a strategic approach to the accessibility of services of general interest (SGI)
- Install a permanent alpine *think tank* on the accessibility to services of general interest
- Encourage the exchange of experiences in the EUSALP perimeter
- Foster synergies with other Action Groups of EUSALP
- Offer ICT solutions for the work of the other action groups

Proposed activities

- Analysis of actual state on infrastructures and digitalization in the Alps
- Identification of quick wins
- Identification on gaps and first ideas for strategic initiatives
- Agreed vision on strategic initiatives
- Start of dialogue with potential partners
- Search funding



Organization of work - Subgroup 2

Proposed activities

- Collection and analysis of SGI strategies
- Elaboration of regional profiles and implementation of new pilot action (PA) in test areas
- Elaboration of proposals for the improvement/adaptation of existing SGI strategies
- Set up of a *think tank* on SGI delivery
