PURPOSE AND LEGAL BASIS OF PROCESSING

3. We process the data that you voluntarily provide and that is necessary for the administration of the

TRANSFER TO THIRD COUNTRIES OR INTERNATIONAL ORGANISATIONS

CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING THE STORAGE PERIOD

Booking data and enrolments: Your data will be stored for 10 years in accordance with the provisions of

the CC.

Publication of website data: Your personal data will be published until cancellation. Details on the

deletion strategy are available on request.

YOUR RIGHTS:

Every data subject has the right to withdraw consent

once given in accordance with Article 7(3) GDPR, the right of access in accordance with Article 15 GDPR, the

right to **rectification** in accordance with Article 16 GDPR, the right to **erasure** in accordance with Article 17

GDPR, the right to **restriction of processing** in accordance with Article 18 GDPR, the right to **object** in

accordance with Article 21 GDPR and the right to data portability in accordance with Article 20 GDPR. You

also have the **right to lodge a complaint** with a data protection supervisory authority (Article 77 GDPR). In

Italy, this authority is the "Garante per la protezione dei dati personali" based in Rome (www.garanteprivacy.it).
